MOZAMBIQUE REBELS BLOW UP TRAIN

African rebels in Mozambique have blown up a train carrying supplies to the Cahora Bassa dam project. Two Portuguese railwaymen were killed. It was reported in Lisbon yesterday.

The guerrillas are thought to have infiltrated across the frontier from sanctuary in Malawi to plant powerful landmines and prepare an ambush on a remote part of the single-line track.

Portuguese combat forces sweeping through a key area near Mozambique's frontier with Rhodesia's troubled eastern district have killed seven rebels and wounded or captured another seven.
