

**Mozambique: shortage of places in post-secondary education**     *(Text)* More than 4,000 people have applied to go to university in Mozambique this year, but there are only about 800 places available. That is according to the Mozambican Sunday newspaper, 'Domingo'. Mozambique has only one university, Eduardo Mondlane, in Maputo city, and more plans (?have yet to be) approved to build a second.
