

Attacks on Frelimo step up

FIGHTERS from the Makonde tribe are mounting a campaign against Frelimo troops in the northern areas of Mozambique, says O Seculo, the Portuguese-language newspaper here.

Dr Kadimbe Kanati, secretary to Makonde leader Lazaro Kavendame, told the newspaper's Lisbon correspondent that the people of Mozambique were opposing Frelimo "oppression".

"All Mozambique is now hoping that the Frelimo military dictatorship will be overthrown soon," he said.

Dr Kanati said he fled to Lisbon from Brussels two months ago after a kidnap attempt.

He was speaking from the home of Dr Domingos Arouca, leader of the United Democratic Front of Mozambique, an anti-Frelimo movement which claims to be establishing a government-in-exile in Spain.
