

"Voice of Free Africa" broadcast (Editorial report) The "Voice of Free Africa" - the station which has a Salisbury postal address and which broadcasts anti-Mozambique government material - in its programme on 21st January, at 1800 gmt in Portuguese, carried the following item datelined Maputo: "Information from this city says that the national resistance forces have engaged in open conflict with [word indistinct] reactionary elements of Samora Machel at a locality situated 60 km from the Mozambican capital, Meanwhile, and according to the same information source [words indistinct] slogans of national resistance (?have been seen) in some parts of Maputo reading: I support the 'Voice of Free Africa' and (?I belong to it)." 2

In the course of the same programme the announcer interrupted music to make the following announcement: "The birds have arrived at the mountain; the fare is coming soon. We repeat: the birds have arrived at the mountain; the fare is coming soon." (Portuguese: "As aves chegaram a montanha; em breve segue transporte.")
