

Mozambique appearance of "enemy agent" Another enemy agent captured by our defence and security forces has been presented to the media. He is Manuel Armando Jambo, from Catembe, Maputo province. He confirmed to newsmen that he was recruited by the enemy in 1976 and underwent military training in Malawi and Rhodesia. He took part in operations in Rhodesia and in Mozambique, including those at Mapai and Chicualacuala, on the side of the Smith forces, and others in Tete, Sofala and Manica. He burnt houses and vehicles and killed civilians. He did reconnaissance work in Nampula province to locate FPLM [armed forces] barracks, re-education camps and other strategic targets for the enemy. His crimes included the planting of mines and torture of captured people. (Maputo in Portuguese 1030 gmt 22 Feb 79)
