

## **Summary of World Broadcasts, 11 April 1979**

Mozambican dissidents' account of rail bridge attack and effect on Zambia (Text of "Voice of Free Africa" report) Lusaka: The Zambian Government has been compelled to stop transporting its exports via Moatize in Tete Province in Mozambique. This decision by the Zambian authorities is the direct result of the destruction of the Mucombeze river railway bridge by Mozambican national resistance forces in December last year. Now, instead of using the railway between Moatize and Beira harbour, the Zambian Government is sending its exports through Malawi. ("Voice of Free Africa" in Portuguese 1630 gmt 9 Apr 79)
