

Reported killing of Mozambican soldiers by Mugabe's forces (Excerpts from "Voice of Free Africa" report) Chimoio [Manica Province]: A Mozambique national resistance patrol has discovered the bodies of two more Mozambican soldiers gunned down by Robert Mugabe's guerrillas for refusing to fight alongside them in Zimbabwe. Many Mozambican soldiers have already been executed by Robert Mugabe's forces for the same reason. Some Mozambican soldiers have been able to run away and join the resistance. . . . It is common knowledge that Samora Machel's Government has been forcing members of the FPLM [People's Forces for the Liberation of Mozambique] soldiers to join Robert Mugabe's guerrillas to support them in the war against Zimbabwe.
