Two murders, Africa (AFP), Dec.29, '81

Maputo, December 26 - Two Portuguese technicians working for a hydro-electrical company in Mozambique were murdered six days ago in the country's north-west, the Mozambican News Agency reported last night. Joachim José Estrela Rato and António Martins Joachim, the agency said, were ambushed when driving in a car in the Guro area of the Province of Manica. The attackers may have been members of the "National Resistance Movement of Mozambique", the agency added, an organisation believed here to enjoy the support of South Africa.
