Renamo To Expand Foreign Political Representation

[Text] The Renamo movement in Mozambique says it intends to increase the number of its political representatives outside the country. In a statement released in Lisbon, the movement said that it would reinforce its presence abroad by naming various militants for posts of major responsibility, with a view to intensifying the organization's political activity.

The statement said that the decision had been taken in West Germany at a meeting chaired by the Renamo leader, Mr Afonso Dhlakama. The movement said it had decided to exercise a vigorous secrecy over any contacts that could lead to a cease-fire agreement between Renamo and the Frelimo government.
