

Beira Pipeline 'Cut'

[Text] Mozambique's national news agency reports MNR guerrillas have killed 21 people in an attack on a town north of Maputo. AIM says about 400 MNR guerrillas attacked the town of Malacha early Tuesday. The agency says 22 people were also injured in the attack.

Meanwhile, MNR rebels say they have killed 20 government soldiers, destroyed 5 patrol boats, and cut an oil pipeline in a series of attacks on Monday. A statement distributed in Lisbon by the rebels says the soldiers were killed on the port of Maputo. They say a section of the pipeline between Zimbabwe and the Mozambican Port of Beira was blown up the same day.
