slams MNR massacre

THE Vietnamese Communist Party's Nhan Dan daily newspaper has condemned the recent killing of 380 people in Mozambique by the MNR bandits.

Early on Saturday morning, July 18, the MNR bandits who had infiltrated from South Africa over the last two months, launched an attack on Homoine in Mozambique's Southern province of Inhambane. Most of those killed were old people, women, children and patients.

In the editorial of July 27, the paper said, "We express our militant solidarity and support to them."
