

Mozambique reportedly tightens security on Swazi border (Text of S African commercial radio report) Drastic tightening of security measures is reported to have been introduced by Mozambique at the country's Swazi border post. Travellers have reported that the closing time at the Lomahasha gate has been changed from 8 pm to 5 pm. In addition all pedestrian traffic across the border has been virtually stopped by Mozambique authorities, who say it is no longer safe. Lomahasha residents say the new measures came into force following a tremendous explosion on the Mozambican side of the border on 4th October, which sparked off a massive security operation by Frelimo forces in the area.
