WORLD TO BID FAREWELL TO AFRICA'S HERO

THE late President Samora Machel of Mozambique will be buried at his country's main Heroes' Acre in Maputo this morning in a ceremony attended by his brother leaders and by the people of the nation he led.

The Prime Minister, Cde Mugabe, arrived in Maputo yesterday for the State funeral.

He was met at Mavalane Airport by Frelimo's most senior member, Cde Marcelino dos Satius, and the party's second secretary, Cde Jose Luis Cabaco.

The Prime Minister was accompanied by the Minister of State (Security), Cde Emmerson Munangagwa, the Minister of Education, Cde Dzingai Mutumbuka, the Minister of State (Defence), Cde Ernest Kadungure, the Minister of Health, Cde Sydney Sekeramayi, the Speaker of the House of Assembly, Cde Didymus Mutasa, the Commander of the Army, Lieut-Gen Rex Nhongo, Minister and the Natural Resources and Cd₉ Victoria Tourism. Five victims of the aircraft crash in which Cde Machel died were burled with full military honours at Maputo Cemetery yesterday morning.

Among them were the former Minister of Transport and Telecommunications, Cde Luis Alcantara Santos, and the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs, Cde', Jose Carlos Lobo, who was also a member of the Central Committee of Freilmo

Fourteen more victims were buried in the afternoon, including personal assistant to Cde Machel, Cde Fernando Honwana; the director of the Centre of African Studies at Edwardo Mondlane University in Maputo, Dr. Aquino da Braganca; and the presidential photographer, Cde Daniel Maquinnasse,

Thousands of Maputo residents packed into the cemetery in the swelter-ing heat to pay their last respects to the heroes.

Among the mourners, politburo members were led by Cde Marcelino Dos Santos and the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Cde Joachim Chissano.

Gun salutes were fired as the coffins were lowered into the graves and moments of silence observed. The proceedings were punctuated by waiting weeping and sobbing from mourners.

Speaking at Mavalane Airport minutes after arriving on the same plane that brought Dr Kaunda, Commonwealth secretary-general, Mr Shridath Ramphal said that South Africa's destabilisation policies must be to blame for the death of Cde Machel, whatever the circumstances that caused the plane to crash.

 South African bantustan leader Chief Buthelezi was refused permission to attend the funeral.

Chief Buthelezi jetted in in a private aircraft with a South African registration number and was told to go back because he had not been invited. South Africa is represented at the funeral by members of the ANC, Umkhonto we Sizwe and the SACP, including Cde Oliver Tambo, Cde Thamas Nkobi and Cde Joe Slovo.—Ziana-AIM-Paua.
