

**S African experts likely to go to Moscow for opening of black-box** South African and international aviation experts are likely to travel to Moscow to be present when the black-box from the crashed plane is opened, according to Johannesburg radio on 28th October, citing Foreign Minister Pik Botha. In a statement in Pretoria, Botha rejected the "flurry of emotional accusations" that South Africa was responsible for the crash. The South African agency cited him as saying that certain political leaders "who show no respect for President Machel's real goals" were now using Machel's death to "sweep up emotions for their own selfish purposes".
