

UZ talks on Machel's life, death

A TWO-DAY series of lectures and talks on the life and death of President Samora Machel will be held at the University of Zimbabwe today and tomorrow.

A lecturer in the department of political science, Cde Chakanyuka Karase, told The Herald yesterday that academics and individuals were monitoring the situation in Mozambique very closely and the lectures which begin this evening at 5.30 pm were designed to ensure that his death would not go unnoticed.

Law lecturer, Cde Kempton Makamure, will talk on who killed Samora Machel and why, while his colleague in the department, Cde Shadreck Ghutto will speak on the man and his ideas.

Cde Karase will talk on the threat of the Mozambique revolution to imperialism and Colonel Gaza of the ZNA will give a lecture on Cde Machel and Zimbabwe's independence struggle.

And tomorrow the series of lectures and talks will continue in the Great Hall with the impact of his death.

Cde Toindepi Masaya of the economics department will talk on the reaction of the people of Zimbabwe to Cde Machel's death and its importance, and a lecturer at the Harare Polytechnic College will talk on the role of imperialism in Southern Africa.
