

**Mozambican President on unemployment and measures against "the enemy"** In a speech at a May Day rally in Maputo, reported by the Pan African agency, President Machel said that unemployed people in the city could easily be "recruited" as "criminals and racketeers" and that they would be "evacuated". He said that 1986 would see a radical transformation in our behaviour towards the enemy; measures would be taken against those "who are compromising with the bandits" and those who had infiltrated the state apparatus would be removed. He also announced the arrest of "the individual responsible" for the car bomb that exploded in Maputo on 21st April (see ME/8247/B/10). *3/5/86*
