

N Korea's promise of more military and other support for Mozambique (Text) Socialist Korea is committed to increase its political, military and economic support for Mozambique in face of the growing tension in southern Africa, it was said in Maputo yesterday. Kim Chae-pung, the Deputy Foreign Minister of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, made the pledge during talks with the delegation from the Mozambican Foreign Ministry. Mr Kim is heading a delegation which is visiting several southern African states, to prepare for the forthcoming summit meeting of the non-aligned movement.
