Mozambican President recovering after surgery in Havana (ME/0296 iii) President Joachim Chissano had an operation for the removal of his prostate on 30th October and was said to be recovering well, the Mozambican agency reported via the Pan-African agency on 1st November. The operation was reported in a communique from the Frelimo Party Political Bureau issued on the 31st. A further medical bulletin, cited by Maputo radio on 1st November, said the President was up and walking and receiving visitors.
