

# END 'IMMORAL FRELIMO' CALL

PAMPHLETS calling on Mozambicans to unite and overthrow the "ignorant, fanatical, disarticulate and politically immoral Frelimo regime" are being distributed in Mozambique by the United Democratic Front of

Mozambique (Fumo).

Fumo, which is headed by Dr Domingos Arouca and supported by highly trained ex-Flecha units operating in northern Mozambique, lists five principles and objectives in the pamphlet, including the formation of a Democratic Republic of Mozambique and a Government that will pledge itself to eliminate poverty and work for freedom and progress.

It also calls for the liberation of the country and an election by all Mozambicans, irrespective of race, and guarantees the people employment and protection of private initiative.

Minimum salaries paid to workers would be guaranteed, depending on the work they do and their abilities, Iana reports.

## CAMP DEATHS

Dr Arouca says in the pamphlet that the Frelimo regime had promised the people of Mozambique liberation after they took over the country, but instead many of them had ended up in forced labour camps. Many had died in these camps.

The regime had clamped down, especially on the poor blacks, and were causing them untold misery, he says.

"It is paradoxical indeed that Frelimo hate Mozambicans, especially the poor black Mozambicans, whom they are now disciplining and impoverishing while at the same time licking the boots of their Russian masters."

Dr Arouca says the introduction of a legitimate democracy in Mozambique would include a co-ordinating commission consisting of 15 members who would make direct contact with people in the country, "especially those persecuted by the police". When Fumo's mission was completed, it would dissolve itself and allow democratic elections in the country.
