Mozambican Foreign Minister denies link with Fernandes's death (ME/0134 ii) The Mozambican Foreign Minister, who arrived in Lisbon on 28th April, has repeated his country's denial that it was linked in any way with the death of "bandit ringleader" Evo Fernandes in Portugal last week, according to Maputo radio. Pascoal Mocumbi told journalists in Lisbon that attempts to connect Frelimo with "terrorist actions such as this one only seek to damage good understanding and co-operation between Mozambique and Portugal, because Evo Fernandes was a Portuguese citizen". He said that since the start of the anti-colonial struggle Frelimo had refrained from any resort to terrorism. On relations with South Africa, Mocumbi said that Mozambique had always been trying to find a way of reviving the Nkomati accord. Mocumbi will visit Czechoslovakia, the GDR and Hungary after Portugal.
