More demands for Costa's expulsion

By Joao Santa Rita A second Portuguese weekly published in Johannesburg has urged the South African Government to expel Mr Jorge Costa, Mozambique's former National Director of Security, who defected last week.

O Seculo said yesterday Mr Costa could not be considered a political refugee.

Another Johannesburg Portuguese weekly, Popular, also called last week for Mr Costa's expulsion.

ACCUSED

Several Portuguese citizens living in South. Africa have accused Mr Costa of being responsible for maltreatment of prisoners and unlawful arrests.

O Seculo said it was "not probable" that South Africa would grant Mr Costa asylum, because if it did so it would be betraying everything it did for Portuguese refugees who had to leave Mozambique.

The paper described Mr Costa as a "miserable opportunist who wants to survive the possible fall of the Machel regime."
