

REFUGEE CAMP OFFICIAL TOOK £120—JAILED

A sentence of two years and 24 strokes has been imposed on Augustino Semwaiko (42) a superintendent of Mugulani Refugee Camp, Dar es Salaam after he pleaded guilty at a Dar es Salaam magistrate's court to a charge of stealing £120 15/- as a public servant.

Insp. Rashid Mauley, alleged that Semwaiko stole the money between February and July 11 when he was engaged in looking after refugees.

His main task was to pay allowances to them. After the refugees had left the camp, Semwaiko continued to prepare payment vouchers, putting the money to his own use.
