

Strike threat

MAPUTO — About 700 primary school teachers in the central Mozambican city of Beira are threatening to go on strike as from Monday in protest against the new wage scale for the Education Ministry that took effect in April, the Maputo daily newspaper Noticias reported yesterday.

These teachers are at the bottom of the salary scale, and their category receives just 54 277 meticaís (about US \$37) a month. — Ziana-AIM-Pana.
