South African agent held

AN AGENT of South Africa's counter-intelligence services has been captured on a reconnaissance mission inside Mozambique. The agent Jaime Mondlane, a Mozambican, who claims to have worked for Pretoria for the past four years, was presented at a news conference in Maputo.

He was captured by Mozambican soldiers in Matola near Maputo city two months ago. Jaime told journalists that he was recruited in 1983 by the South African counter-intelligence services to work as an interpreter.
