

Radio's report on presence of Russians and Cubans in Nacala (Excerpt from "Voice of Free Africa" radio report) A letter from Nacala sent to the (?Zilito) movement, which sent it on to us, says: We insistently ask the Mozambican national resistance not to forget the oppressed people of Nacala. This Mozambican in Nacala also says in his letter that Nacala harbour is full of Russians, Cubans and Tanzanians, armed to the teeth, who rape women and girls. [He adds that] in this desperate situation created by the present political situation in Mozambique and revolted by the Machel regime, the people of Nacala set fire and burn down depots where war equipment is kept.
