

# Mozambique insurgent commander killed

The anti-Frelimo Mozambique National Resistance Movement has admitted losing its military commander, Andre Matsangai, in a clash with Government forces.

In a statement released in Johannesburg the movement said it had been involved in heavy fighting with Frelimo troops.

The statement said the

clashes took place over a large area of southern Mozambique.

It follows the arrival in Zimbabwe of scores of Mozambican refugees who said they had fled fighting in Gaza Province.

The MRM statement did not expand on how Commander Matsangai was killed, merely stating that he died in action recently.

It said his place had been taken by Commander Alfonso Jacamo.
