

## **Machel on Mozambique's "internal enemy"**

President Machel, in his opening address at the sixth session of the People's Assembly on 21st July, relayed by Maputo radio, said that Zimbabwe's independence, a victory for Africa, should serve as a lesson to South Africa in its obstinacy over Namibia. The task of African political liberation was not yet over; for example, there was "the expansionist and colonial presence of Morocco in the SADR", and despite the recent independence of Zimbabwe, there were still inside Mozambique small gangs of bandits supported by people abroad. "On 18th March, we took the historic decision to turn the muzzles of our guns inside our country. We officially declared war against the internal enemy."
