## **Mozambican dissidents' reported decision to seek external assistance**

Johannesburg radio, again citing "Radio Free Africa" as its source (see ME/6899/ii), said the Mozambique National Resistance had announced it was considering requesting external assistance to intensify the guerrilla war against President Machel's Government; "the resistance clandestine radio station said this decision had been taken in view of the fact that the Mozambique Government had requested military assistance from Zimbabwe to fight the guerrilla opposition."
