## Mozambique Reports Abduction in Game Park

Guerrillas have kidnapped two foreign teachers at Mozambique's best-known wildlife park, the Defense Ministry has announced.

A ministry spokesman said Saturday that the kidnapping took place about 500 miles north of here at the Gorongosa Park in the center of this nation in southeastern Africa on Dec. 17.

The teachers are John Burlison, 28 years old, a British ecologist who is academic director of the Wildlife School at Gorongosa, and Moises Carril, mathematics teacher at the same school. Mr. Carril's nationality was not immediately reported.

The spokesman said the kidnappers were members of the National Mozambique Resistance, a group the Government says is backed by South Africa.
