

**Further arrests of Portuguese in Beira (ME/7239/B/8: text)** Two more Portuguese citizens have been detained in Beira following investigations into activities against the security of the Mozambican state. That was reported yesterday by the Mozambican news agency, AIM. The people in question are Antonio Fernandes Joaquim [phonetic] da Fonseca, a ship's master working with the Beira Industrial Fishing Company, and Antonio Martins da Silva Guerra, official in charge of services of the East African Shipping Enterprise [name given in English]. Antonio Joaquim da Fonseca was accused of publicly spreading propaganda about the activities of the armed bandits in our country among people with whom he was living, and among his workmates. As for Antonio Guerra, he was detained on charges of selling his house in Beira for foreign currency to the Mozambique Manica Freight Services Company with the complicity of the director of this enterprise, (?Henry) Don Hamilton [a Briton], who is also currently detained on suspicion of complicity in acts of sabotage.
