

S Africa and Mozambique The South African government had finally gone public over its support for the MNR terrorists, Maputo radio said in a broadcast in English for southern Africa on 2nd June. "Today they officially opened the first public headquarters of the MNR in South Africa . . . in Durban, one of South Africa's main cities" (ME/8274/ii). True to form, the radio said, the head of the office would not be a Mozambican but a member of a Portuguese family that had owned businesses in Maputo and who "ran away after the African people of Mozambique took power".
