S Africa and Mozambique The South African government had finally gone public over its support for the MNR terrorists, Maputo radio said in a broadcast in English for southern Africa on 2nd June. "Today they officially opened the first public headquarters of the MNR in South Africa...in Durban, one of South Africa's main cities" (ME/8274/ii). True to form, the radio said, the head of the office would not be a

Mozambican but a member of a Portuguese family that had owned businesses in Maputo
