

Reported attempt by Mozambican rebels to open office in S Africa (Text) The armed bandits are carrying out a campaign to open various representations in South Africa with main offices located in Durban, AIM reports. The plan is being carried out by Pedro Buccelato, a former officer with the South African armed forces, who admits being an armed bandit sympathiser. Buccelato, who was apparently born in Italy and became a Portuguese citizen and later South African, said that other offices will be located next to the camps of illegal Mozambican immigrants in South Africa. According to AIM, the South African government did not approve of the opening of the offices, but according to Pretoria sources, the Department of Foreign Affairs is studying the possibility of approving Buccelato's plan.
