

**MNR's reported claims including killing of two Cubans** (Text) Renamo [MNR] has issued a statement in Lisbon saying it shot dead 139 government troops in recent fighting in three areas in Mozambique. The anti-government movement said two of the attacks were launched in the northwestern province of Tete, while the third was on a goods train outside Maputo. (Johannesburg home service in English 0915 gmt 26 Jun 86)

(Text) The Renamo movement of Mozambique says its forces killed 91 government troops and two Cubans in three separate attacks in the past two weeks. A Renamo statement issued in Lisbon said 19 government troops were killed in an attack on a military base near the port of Beira . . . and 41 in an attack on the town Chire in the central Zambezia province. In another attack on the town of Boane, about 40 km southwest of the capital, Maputo, 31 government troops and two Cubans were killed. Renamo did not mention whether it suffered any casualties in the three clashes. (Johannesburg in English for abroad 0630 gmt 29 Jun 86)
