

**Mozambique and Angola: In Brief**

**Mozambican government military claims** (Excerpts) The FPLM forces recently killed four armed bandits in Dambe, Sussundenga district, in Manica province. The criminals were killed when they tried to attack a communal village. . . . Two armed bandit camps were destroyed at Mussorize, also in Manica province, a few days ago. . . . (Maputo in Portuguese 0400 gmt 25 Jun 86)

(Text) Units of the Mozambican army have killed 14 terrorists belonging to the South African MNR bandit gang. The terrorists were killed during attacks by the army on a bandit camp in the district of Jangamo, in southern Inhambane province, and on a group of terrorists in Morrumbene district, also in Inhambane. During these operations on 15th and 17th June, the army also recovered goods stolen from the local population by the South African terrorist force.
