

Mozambican rebels claim capture of towns Members of the Mozambique National Resistance (MNR) have captured the towns of Alto Molocue and Licuati in Mozambique's Zambezia Province, AFP reported on 29th September, citing an MNR spokesman in Lisbon. The spokesman added that the MNR had killed over 130 government troops in clashes the previous week in the north of the country and near the capital. The MNR had also attacked the government military HQ for Maputo Province at Pessane, killing seven soldiers and destroying a bridge on the railway linking Maputo to the South African border (see ME/8375/ii). 30/9/86
