

Disruption of Mozambican railway by mine explosion (Text) A mine exploded early today on the railway between Maputo and South Africa, interrupting railroad traffic between the two countries, according to a source from the Mozambique railway. The source revealed that the explosion damaged 900 m of rail and caused seven wagons of a goods train which was travelling from Maputo to Ressano Garcia near the border with South Africa to derail.
