Mozambique says S Africans commanding MNR operations Citing Mozambican security sources, Maputo radio reported on 5th November that seven South African commandos were in charge of operations by the Mozambique National Resistance movement in the Mutarara area of Tete province. The source added that three Portuguese commandos currently in the South African army were leading operations in the Inchope area of Sofala province*. The Pan-African agency reported that the Inchope area is where the road to Maputo branches off the Beira-Zimbabwe road and is an important area for the defence of the Beira Corridor.
