

“Bandits” from Malawi attack Mozambique border town (Text) Maputo, 9th November: An official Mozambican government source told AIM today that bandit gangs infiltrating from Malawi have attacked the town of Ulongue, capital of the fertile district of Angonia in the north-western province of Tete. The attack began yesterday at about 06.00 local time [04.00 gmt], the spokesman did not specify how many bandits had infiltrated into Angonia from Malawi. Ulongue is just 20 km from Malawi's western border with Mozambique. Several localities in the provinces of Tete and Zambezia have come under MNR bandit attack after the large-scale bandit invasion from Malawian soil which began at the end of September.
