

S African airline denies role in covert operations On 15th November Johannesburg radio reported that the privately-owned South African airline, Comair, had denied that it was involved in any flights or covert operations in Mozambique or Angola. The company's managing director, Mr P. van Hoven, said that Mozambican allegations about such involvement were totally false. Earlier, Maputo radio, in a report on Mr van Hoven's role in the inquiry into President Machel's death, had said that Comair was involved in supplying arms to rebels in Angola and Mozambique. 17/11/86
