

MP's warning to border population after possible MNR raid in Zimbabwe (Text) The ZANU-PF MP for Mutare East constituency, Comrade Lazarus Nzarayebani, has called for maximum vigilance among the people living along the border with Mozambique. Comrade Nzarayebani made the call when he addressed a rally at (?Riba) village in the (?Dinga) mining area of Manicaland province. The call comes in the wake of reports that armed men, believed to be MNR bandits, robbed a bus in the area on Christmas Day. Police say follow-up operations are in progress to try and track down the (?six) armed men. The bandits are said to have robbed 83 dollars from the bus conductor but no one was injured.
