

Mozambique: Renamo military claim (Text) Mozambican rebels claim they have captured a strategic railroad town in the central part of the country, allegedly killing 86 soldiers. An MNR spokesperson claims the rebels have captured Semacueza, 50 km north of the Indian Ocean port of Beira. The town is on the strategic railroad that runs north from Beira to landlocked Malawi. The rebels claim their attacks have been the railroad unusable for the past three years. There as been no independent confirmation of these claims. (Capital Radio, Umtata in English 0600 gmt 4 Jan 87)
