

Red Cross says 38 expatriates still missing in Mozambique (Excerpt) Harare 7th January: At least 38 expatriates are still missing in Mozambique despite the release, just before Christmas, of 65 hostages held by the rebel MNR, the head of the southern Africa mission of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), Ulrich Bedert, said in Harare today. "We will try our best to continue to be a mutual intermediary, for humanitarian reasons, to all parties involved until there are indications of the whereabouts of these people", he told the semi-official Ziana news agency in an interview. . .
