

**Mozambique: "Bandits" destroy Nampula power station** (Text) A group of armed bandits, who attacked district headquarters of Monapo village, Nampula province, on the morning of 2nd January, killed eight people and abducted several others. The bandits simultaneously attacked the Monapo administrative village and its industrial area. The group that attacked the industrial area used explosives at the electric power station, destroyed a wagon with 30 tons of cashew nuts and burned cotton bales from the Monapo seed cleaning and pressing factory. In their murderous fury the armed bandits destroyed the Monapo rural hospital and the electric power station of that village. The Monapo village electric power station was used as a power station to transform and distribute electrical energy from Nacala to Nampula town, Isle of Mozambique, and Mossuril district.
