

MNR claims to have killed a senior Tanzanian officer in Mozambique The Mozambique National Resistance movement (MNR) has claimed to have killed a Tanzanian battalion commander in fighting in Mozambique, according to Lisbon radio. The rebels say that Salim Amani (phonetic) was killed during an MNR attack in an area 70 km from Maputo between the Mozambican capital and Manhica. An MNR representative in Lisbon, Paulo Oliveira, said that the officer had been travelling in a convoy which was attacked by the MNR.
