**Mozambique: Armed Forces claim strategic "bandit" camps destroyed** (Text) The armed forces stationed in Mocuba district, Zambezia province, killed 130 bandits during December 1986. During the same period, the Mozambican forces destroyed armed bandit camps at (?Namanjadirre), (?Magiue), (?Monhuba) and (?Nambevo), where they also captured enemy arms and freed a number of people. Military sources told AIM that (?Namanjadirre) and (?Nambevo) camps were strategic for the armed bandits, because it was from these that they launched attacks against trucks and murdered their occupants. Following the destruction of these camps, security along the road between Quelimane and Mocuba has improved over the last few days. (Maputo home service in Portuguese 0700 gmt 24 Jan 87)
