

Mozambique: four killed in MNR attack near Maputo (Text) Four peasants were killed and several others wounded in an attack by the South African-backed MNR terrorists in a zone 15 km west of Maputo city on Monday. According to today's edition of the Maputo daily newspaper 'Noticias', the bandits entered a residence there on Monday night and killed four people of the same family using firearms and axes. Many people in the zone were kidnapped and threatened with death if they did not follow the terrorists' orders. Two children were among the survivors who are now receiving treatment at the Maputo central hospital. When chasing the bandits, the Mozambican Armed Forces freed several people who had been forced to live with the terrorists. (Maputo in English for abroad 1100 gmt 13 Feb 87)
