

Mozambique: 50 people killed in attack on tea factories “Armed bandits in the pay of South Africa” killed about 50 people and sabotaged five tea-processing factories in the district of Gurue in the central Mozambican province of Zambezia on 12th February, Maputo radio reported, adding that the raid was led by three white men. According to the report, the Mozambican armed forces re-established control over the area on 16th February.*
