Mozambique: "bandits" attack Matola co-operatives (Text) The South African-backed MNR bandits attacked two consumer co-operatives in the town of Matola, 15 km west of Maputo City, on Thursday night. The bandits severely damaged the installations of the co-operatives and made off with substantial quantities of maize, flour, rice, sugar, cooking oil and other items.
