

MNR bandits strike

BANDITS of the South African backed Mozambique National Resistance (MNR) attacked two consumer co-operatives in the city of Matola, about 15 kilometres west of Maputo last Thursday night, according to a report in the daily newspaper, Noticias.

The raiders severely damaged the installations of the co-operatives, and made off with substantial quantities of maize, flour, rice, sugar, cooking oil and cigarettes.

On the same night the bandits also set fire to a taxi in Matola.
